Provide industrial engineering expertise for the support of manufacturing operations and improvements of medical device products lines. This will include devising efficient systems that integrate workers, machines, materials, and information using a Value Stream Map approach.

The industrial engineer's responsibilities will include creating flow by analyzing operations, designing workflows and production processes that ensure that final products meet the established quality standards.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Value Stream map current state and future state for key products/families including. Develop supporting plan/actions to achieve future state.
- Analyze work content utilizing observations and time studies for the purpose of implementing line balancing with standard work (sequence of steps, cycle time, defined WIP) for each processing step.
- Design production processes that maximize efficiency and reduce waste (e.g., transportation, inventory, movement, waiting, over production, over processing, defects)
- Develop Leader Standard Work to sustain and improve standard work and other Lean improvements.
- Assist with designing layout of facilities including making the flow visual.
- Train staff on new processes, including written instructions and standard work.
- Evaluate labor standards, headcount requirements and costs to reflect current performance.

- Support manufacturing to produce products meeting Eagle Labs quality standards, cost targets, and production schedules.
- Participate in daily production and accountability meetings.
- Assist with 5S implementation as needed.
- Write work instructions as needed.
- Provide cost and expense information as required to accounting.
- Perform other duties as assigned by manager.
